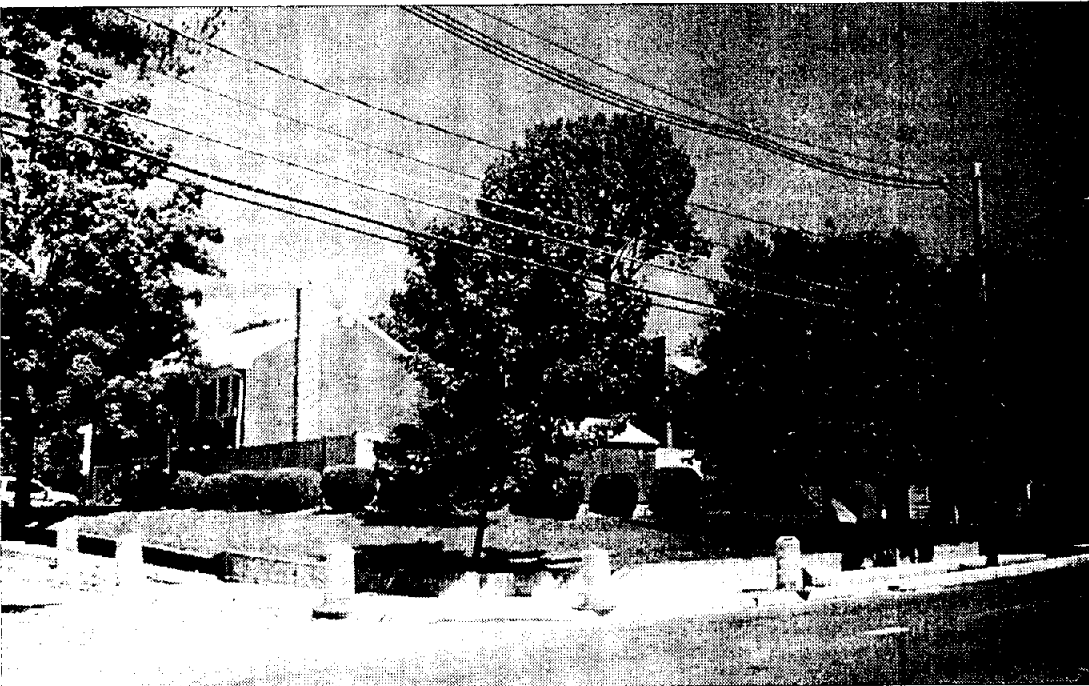


THEN & NOW



A one-room schoolhouse was built on the corner of Lowell and Hartshorn streets in 1866 and had, by 1864, a total of 37 students in grades 1 to 5. In 1909 this building was destroyed by fire and rebuilt as a two-story structure in 1911. It was fully occupied in 1914 with grades 1 to 4. This school was closed in 1977 and the area was cleared for the building of new homes. A number of homes occupy this area today. Earlier this summer, Lowell Street was being resurfaced and new curbing and sidewalks were being added.
