Ms. Webb asked the percentage completion for the new school. She was told 78%.

Superintendent Schettini stated he had been working on the finalization of the FY04 Budget. He stated that because of the hard work to obtain circuit breaker money for Special Education and they decreased the number of outside placements, there are funds to address district wide issues. He stated he would like to make some transfers.

Mr. Dahl made a motion that the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) be transferred from the School Department's Special Needs Budget to the Reading Memorial High School Construction and Renovation Project.
