- Ending the purchase of expensive curriculum with deficiencies that require supplementing, teacher training, parental tutoring, and renewable workbooks.
- More equitable funding for band, drama and athletic programs.
- Correcting curriculum deficiencies that presently leave many students behind.
- Not diverting \$310,000 for high school technology into non-essential, non reimbursable items like bleachers, press box, etc.
- Responsible school spending: The Barrows project has been reduced by 8,000 sq. ft., 1 classroom deleted, "community gym" downsized, while costs increased \$1.5 million. Architects for the elementary projects over-billed the town \$146,000 and went undetected until I uncovered over-billing errors and notified town officials. I questioned the necessity of awarding a \$7,500 bonus to a departing superintendent.
- Stopping wasteful spending to preserve more for students and classroom needs.

For the last 4 years I have regularly attended School Committee meetings. I know about school issues; budgets, curriculum, special education, and school building projects. I have always advocated for academic excellence while ensuring every dollar is well spent.
